

## Learning from what He Said

John 17:3 <sup>3</sup> "And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.

Jesus said that God wants us to know Him and His Messiah. He is a person with desires, wants, feelings, and goals in His life. This is an unusual view in the Christian world as the majority is consumed with a belief of sovereignty that effectively turns Him into a God of Stone. Just as the Pagan Greek Philosophers taught that God cannot have emotions, and nothing happens outside of His total control and design, this has also been the belief most commonly perpetuated in the Christian world.

People believe in destiny and providence in various forms because it is the most appealing to the religious flesh. The end result is that they do not know God. They might know of Him, and they might know some of the things He said and did, but they don't know Him as a person. You cannot have a relationship with a God who is not relational, and that is exactly what people imagine through their distorted views of God's sovereignty. Again, you cannot have a relationship with a God who is not relational, and a God in total control is not relational.

John 16:12-13 <sup>12</sup> "I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. <sup>13</sup> "However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.

It should be relatively obvious that neither you nor I have a complete understanding of all truth. We have a God who wants to speak to us and guide us into truth, and He does this as we are able to understand a little at a time. When a person is saved, they begin this new relationship with God, and they know very little truth. Just making the decision to surrender to the New Covenant is a challenging step for most everyone. He speaks to us through His Holy Spirit a little at a time as we live our daily lives. We ask Him questions and He responds or waits for another time to respond. He gives us insights into what He sees through our eyes and hears through our ears. He uses the experiences we have on an individual basis to help us increase our understanding of the truth. This is how He relates to us as a relational God.

When we understand the world we are a part of through His point of view, we do get to know Him more as a person. When He relates to us in our daily circumstances, we get to know Him in a unique way through our personal moments in life. We share our lives with Him, just as He shares His life with us, and this forms a unique bond between us and our God that is personal to each one of us.

God wants to be in our lives individually. He wants us to know the truth He defines and how to apply the truth in our daily lives. He wants us to learn about Him personally through what He shares about our personal circumstances. We will know Him in a way no one else can relate to when they rely on the study of the Bible alone.

For this relationship to be real, we also need to decide that we want to know Him. This is a mutual decision of God being a part of our life, and us being a part of His. You will probably have noticed that very few people want to know who He is, what He values, what He thinks, what is important to Him and what He is doing. I am confident He would like more people in His life who will relate to Him in this way, but I can tell He really enjoys the few He gets. Every generation provides Him with a new group of people.
